Dear visitors,

After a careful review of the Respiratory surveillance reports indicating current Moderate Influenza activity in the community, and Low COVID community transmission we are updating our visitors' protocols.

Effective immediately, visitors are to continue wearing surgical masks while in the facility. Visitors no longer are required to do a rapid antigen test prior to entry.

We will continue to monitor the community transmission via the NSW Respiratory Surveillance Summary and adjust our response, including mask requirements as needed.

We kindly request that all visitors continue to sign in via our Looplearn kiosk which will conduct temperature checks and health screening.

A reminder to also maintain good hand hygiene and utilise the provided hand sanitizers throughout our facilities. If you are experiencing any Flu like symptoms, or feeling unwell, we kindly ask that you refrain from visiting the facility to help us ensure the safety of our residents and staff.
